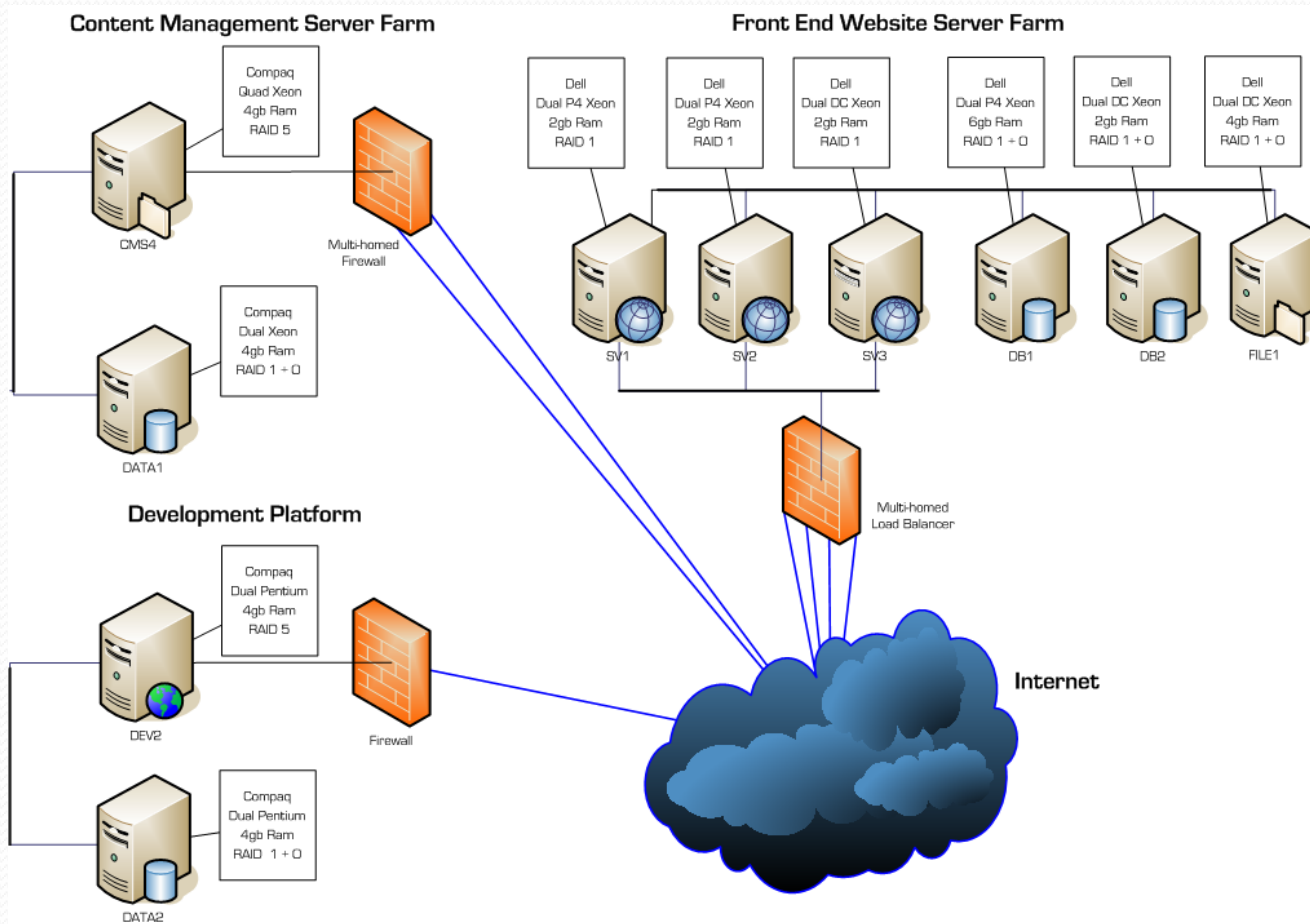

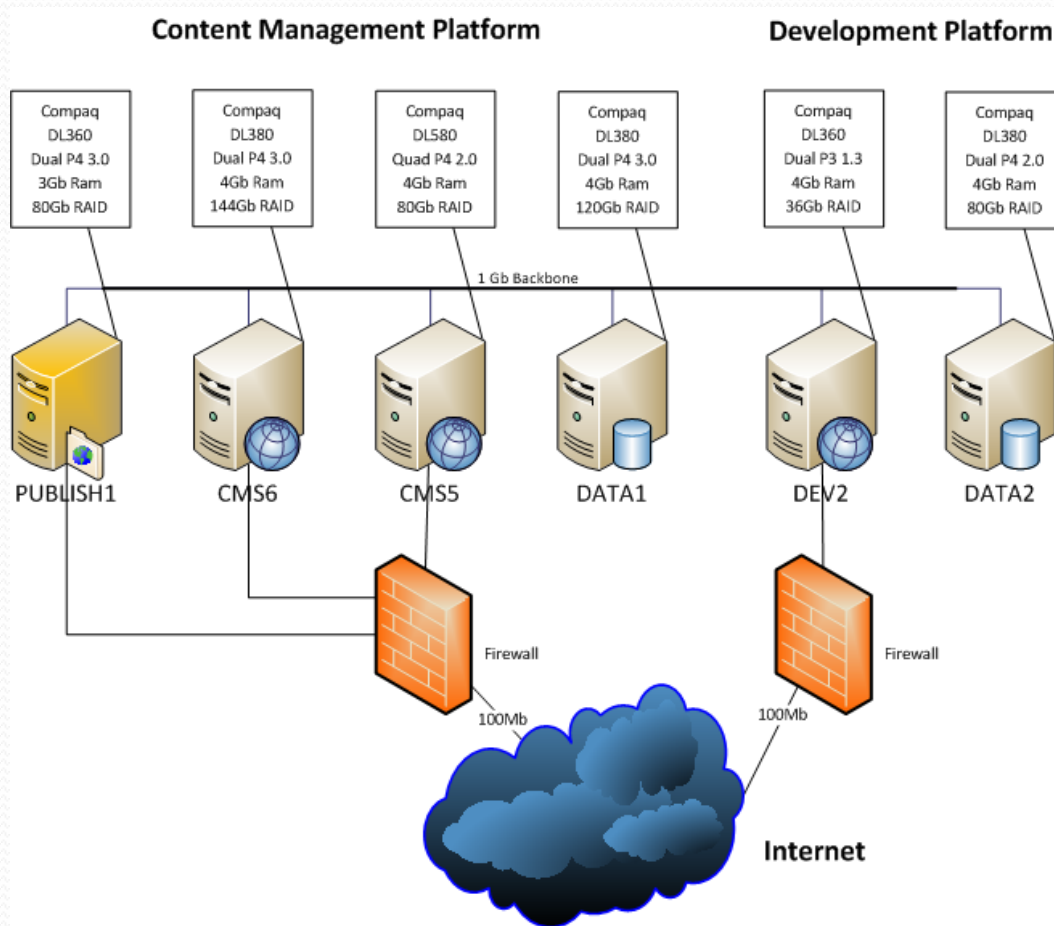

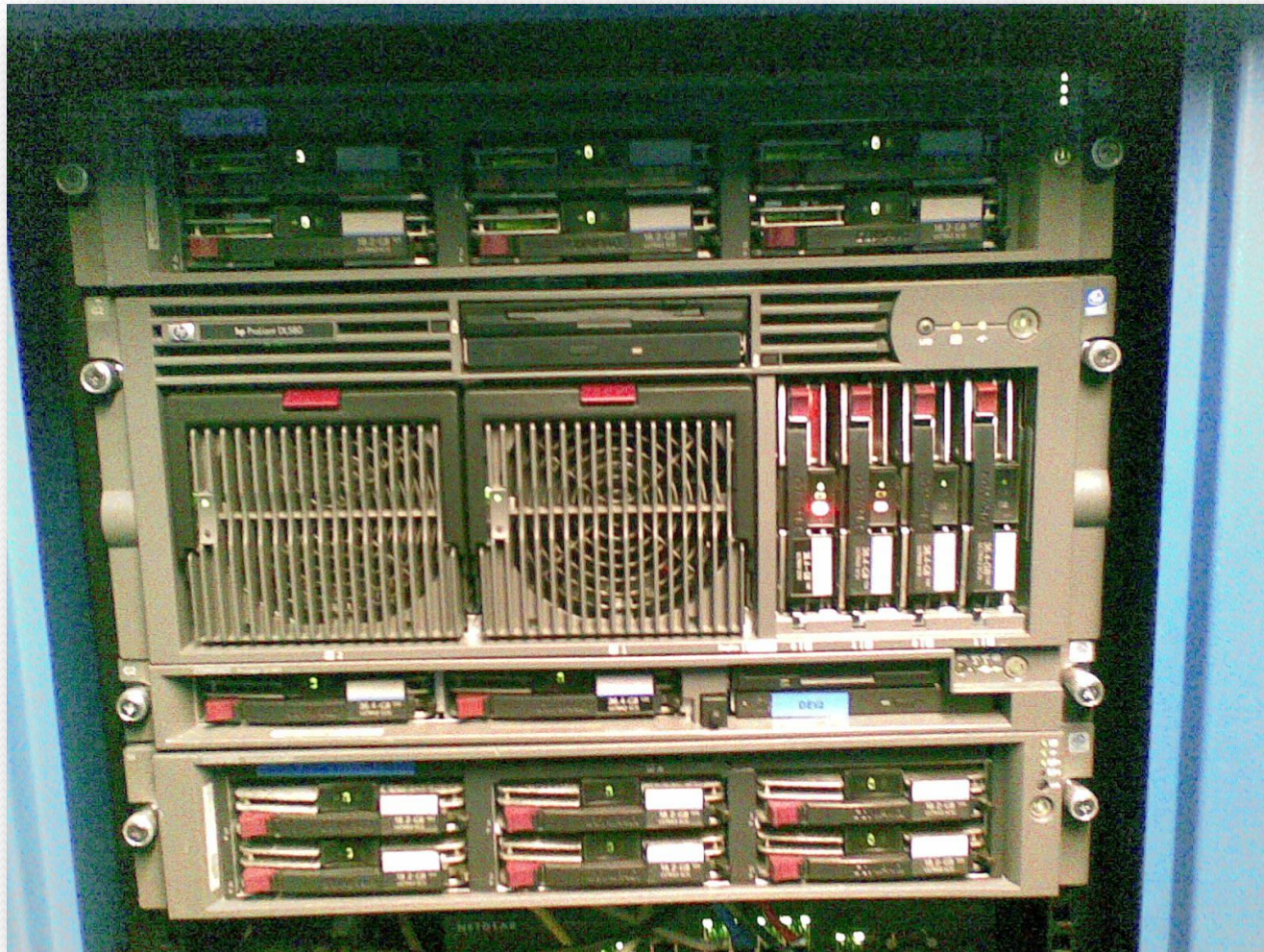
Sotic Website Platform

Correct Specification

- Separate SQL server to CMS server
- SQL server not Express
- A real server not desktops
- Minimum of two cores / twin processor
 - However Reddot does not utilise any more than two
- Fast disks, with a caching raid controller
- 1gb interconnects, server class network cards

Look after the platform

- Regular patching – hardware and operating system
- Nightly disk defragmenting
- Clean up the disk space
 - Reddot\asp\logs
 - Windows\system32\logfiles\W3SVC1
- MSDAC – correct version
- Configure virus checking to be less intrusive

Sharing the load

- Investigate the cluster approach
- Change to directory publishing and use a 3rd party tool to carry out the FTP
- Move publishing to another server
- Golden rule –
 - Let Reddot do what it does with nothing else on the box
 - Reddot wants all the toys to itself
